Notice is hereby given of the 51st Annual General Meeting of Dorset Ramblers which will be held at 11.00 am on SATURDAY THE 29 NOVEMBER 2025 at Broadmayne Village Hall, Cowleaze Road, Broadmayne, DT2 8EW

The business to be conducted will be as stated in Clause 12 of the Dorset Area Constitution. You can read the constitution on our website here.

Each individual member of the Area and one representative of each affiliated local organisation in membership of the Area is entitled to attend and vote.

There is car parking at the village hall (please car share if possible) but Broadmayne can also be reached by public transport. The number 5 bus reaches the village from both Dorchester and Weymouth at times which are convenient for the meeting (see here for the timetable).

Please don't be put off by the formal notice of the meeting. This is an event for all members in Dorset and everyone is welcome. Do come along and meet walking friends from across Dorset, Bournemouth, Christchurch & Poole and hear what has been achieved in the last year, elect our Area Council members for the coming year, learn about proposals to change the way the Ramblers is organised, and hear from our guest speakers. The name of the guest speaker from Ramblers central office has yet to be confirmed, but we should be hearing about the Wessex Wanderer Railway Walks programme - circular and linear walks of various lengths which start and finish from stations along the Heart of Wessex (Bristol to Weymouth) railway line. This initiative began in 1995, and so is celebrating its 30th anniversary this year.

And it's not all listening; there will be plenty of opportunity to talk to Area Officers over a congenial shared lunch after the AGM (please bring a plate of either savoury or sweet food for sharing).

One of the main tasks of the AGM is to elect our Area Council members, and other posts for the coming year.
