Why this walk is a favourite	A walk around Badbury Rings offers a scenic blend of history and nature, taking in the Iron Age hill fort and the rolling Dorset countryside. The circular route winds through ancient woodland, open fields, and quiet tracks lined with wildflowers in spring and summer. Panoramic views from the top of the rings provide a striking look across Cranborne Chase and beyond. It's a peaceful and moderately easy walk, ideal for soaking up the rural charm and rich heritage of the area.
