

Walk title/location	Isle of Wight-Alum Bay to Yarmouth - linear
Why this walk is a favourite	The ramble from Alum Bay to Yarmouth offers breathtaking coastal views and a varied landscape, passing by the iconic Needles and Tennyson Down. Walkers are treated to sweeping sea vistas, chalk cliffs, and peaceful woodland paths. The trail is rich in history and natural beauty, with opportunities to spot wildlife. Arriving in Yarmouth, the bustling harbour and quaint streets make a perfect end to the journey.
Start and finish points	SZ 30791 85432 PO39 0JD
Distance in miles	8.1
Key viewpoints	Panoramic views of the South Coast from Tennyson Down. National Trust exhibition of buildings where rockets were tested in the Cold War era.
Parking/public transport	Pay and Display car park at Lymington Ferry Terminal. Ferry to Yarmouth. Short walk to bus garage for the bus to Alum Bay. The walk is then a linear return to Yarmouth.
