

Walk title/location	Lepe
Why this walk is a favourite	The walk begins at Lepe Country Park, heading northwest through woodland and open countryside. The route then loops inland before turning back toward the coast. The return is made along the beach, where waves and seabirds provide a scenic backdrop. There are also views of the Isle of Wight.
Start and finish points	SZ 45602 98486 SO45 1AD
Distance in miles	4.7
Key viewpoints	You can see The Millennium Beacon Lighthouse and views of the Isle of Wight across the Solent.
Parking/public transport	<p>Pay and display at Lepe Country Park.</p> <p>Bus Services:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bluestar Line 9: This bus operates hourly from Southampton Central Station to the Whitefield Farm stop, which is the nearest to Lepe Country Park. From Whitefield Farm, it's about a 20-minute walk to the park. [link] • Summer Beach Bus: During the summer months, a seasonal Beach Bus service runs from Hythe to Lepe Country Park, providing a direct connection.
Level	Easy
Accessibility	No stiles. At high tide, instead of returning along the beach, switch to the road which runs parallel.
