


## Dorset Area of the Ramblers: Favourite Walks

Title of walk	Weymouth History walk
Why this walk is a favourite	Interesting sweep of history within a relatively short and easy walk.
Linear or circular walk	Circular
Start and finish point(s)	Weymouth Railway station SY 680 796
Distance	5 miles
Key viewpoints	Nothe Fort (Victorian), Sandsfoot Castle (Henry VIII)
Parking/public transport	There is parking at the nearby Swannery car park and the area is well-served with buses.
Level	Easy
Accessibility	<p>This walk is generally suitable for wheelchairs.</p> <p>This walk is largely flat and with no stiles, and encompasses most of the key historical sites within Weymouth centre including Nothe Fort and Sandsfoot Castle, the port which dates from the medieval era and the Georgian seafront loved by George III. The outward walk follows a small part of the SWCP and returns via the Rodwell Trail on the disused Weymouth-Portland railway line.</p>
