Why this walk is a favourite	White Sheet Hill, located in Wiltshire, England, is a scenic chalk downland known for its sweeping views and ancient history. It's a popular spot for walking, with gentle trails that pass through wildflower-rich grasslands and archaeological features like Bronze Age burial mounds.

Distance in miles	4.8
Key viewpoints	On clear days, you can see across the Vale of Wardour and beyond.
Parking/public transport	Dirt car park
Level	Moderate
Accessibility	Three stiles.
