

Walk title/location	Worth Matravers To Dancing Ledge
Why this walk is a favourite	This circular walk from Worth Matravers heading west offers stunning rural views as you make your way toward the dramatic cliffs of the Jurassic Coast. Descending to the coast path, the route hugs the rugged shoreline, with the sound of waves below and wide sea views ahead as you approach the striking rock platform of Dancing Ledge. After a pause to take in the scenery—or perhaps watch adventurous swimmers—you turn inland, climbing gently back via the ancient Priest's Way, a historic route once used by clergy. The path leads you through rolling fields and stone-walled lanes, returning you to Worth Matravers with a real sense of Dorset's wild beauty and timeless charm.
Start and finish points	SY 97421 77582 BH19 3LE
Distance in miles	7.3
Key viewpoints	Stunning sea views and in good weather Portland in the distance. Dolphins are frequently seen along this coastline. At the end is the Square and Compass pub serving several local real ales, pasties, etc.
Parking/public transport	Car parking at the village car park payable with JustPark app.
Level	Hard
Accessibility	Two stiles. There are challenging slopes with and without steps. However, if the walk becomes too difficult there are three signposted routes back to the start in Worth Matravers.
